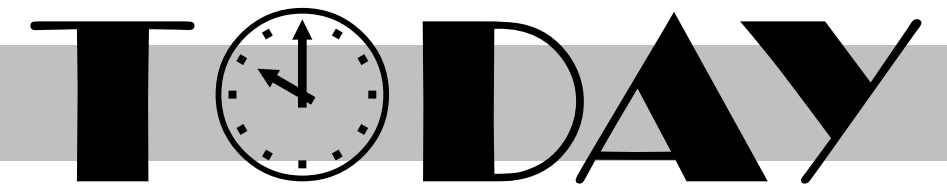


# Why?

Why are so many cars parked on both sides of the neighborhood streets? It is a mess around here! I recently had a question about curbside parking in our neighborhood. The question dealt less with the immediately adjacent streets to church entrances than to the other streets nearby. It seems that the area is getting more congested with cars, people, bikes and pets. The athletic fields north of MMS, south of Mac Haik Ford, cause a lot of congestion when games and practices take place. And Attingham is particularly a problem when both sides have cars parked there. I am mostly concentrated on Perthshire/Tallowood Road and Vindon but I realize congestion affects us even while you drive to church. My suggestion is to find alternative routes at times you know to be busy. Be careful near Bendwood Park also. There are lots of pedestrians there at virtually all times when we are in meetings at the church. The fact is: we live in a highly populated area and it is becoming even more congested each year. I hope we can find a way to reach all of those folks who are involved in activity when we are in church. I suggest being friendly and accommodating to all you meet and not let the challenge of dodging cars, people or pets become a stress point for you. This is one of those, "as you go..." opportunities mentioned in the Great Commission. Help and bless those who are also experiencing the congestion. "No parking" signs are placed by our staff on the south side of Perthshire each Sunday morning in order to keep traffic flowing well. We don't place such signs anywhere else. They are used to accommodate the community as well as our membership. Please be aware of the opportunity, given to us each day, to exercise patience and grace, particularly when you are behind the wheel.
